I am the above named person and my address is as shown overleaf.

On Monday 5th June 2006, at approximately 1445hrs, I entered the Coronary Care Unit, Chesterfield Royal Hospital, with my sister Karen, in order to see my mother who is ill and is being treated in the unit.

When we went into the unit I saw that my 2 brothers Adrian and Graham were already present and were sat with my mother. We therefore joined them.

About 5-10 minutes later, a nurse asked us to go outside the care unit, as they needed to perform an ECG scan on my mother.

X Karen stayed with my mother, and I went and sat in the corridor outside the unit with Adrian and Graham.

Whilst we were sat in the corridor, a number of visitors, who were of Asian or Indian race,

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we were coming and going from the Coronary Care Unit. As 1 male As race of Ben was leaving the corridor as if to leave the hospital, Adrian said something like, "HOW COME WHEN THERE IS MORE THAN ONE OF THEM, THEY TALK IN THEIR OWN LANGUAGE?"

The male that was leaving the corridor, then stopped at the door, turned round and walked back in our direction.

This male was of Asian race, in his early 20's, of slim build, about 6'0" tall, with short dark coloured wavy hair, with flecks of ginger in the hair. He was wearing a black pinstripe suit, with a white striped shirt.

The male walked towards Adrian, bent over so that his face was about 2 inches from Adrian's face, and he started shouting at Adrian. I cannot remember what it was about, other than it was about the comment that Adrian made to me.

I then stood up and said to the male that we were in a coronary care unit and we didn't want any trouble.

He was ~~breath~~ seemed to be hyperventilating, as he was breathing in and out forcefully into my face. He replied, "COME OUTSIDE AND WE'LL SORT IT OUT", and he then continuously called me an "UGLY BASTARD".

The male then pushed me 2-3 times in the chest.

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He then turned back to Adrian, and shouted that he wanted an apology.

Adrian said, "I'M SORRY", and the male then told me to apologise.

I said, "I'M NOT APOLOGISING", and the male told me to sit down. He also kept saying, 'COME OUTSIDE.'

I said that I would sit down when I was ready, and the male then punched me in my left eye using his right fist, breaking my glasses.

I then grabbed the male, although I can't remember where I grabbed him, and we stumbled into the wall. The male's back was against the wall, and he pushed his finger a number of times into my left eye, causing me a lot of pain, as I wrestled with him to get him off.

I best ducked my head to try and stop the male pushing his finger into my eye, and I then felt him biting the back of my head.

The next thing I remember is Adrian attempting to pull the male off of me.

Adrian and the male then bundled each other through the doors into the Coronary Care Unit.

I then picked up my glasses followed them into the Unit and saw that Adrian was trying to hold the male against the wall using his hands, and the

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male was screaming and shouting.

I went to help Adrian, and attempted to hold
 him as male's arms by his sides, pressing my
 weight against his chest.

At this point a number of staff were trying to
 calm the male down also, as he was in a
 rage.

I then let go and backed away, and staff
 members stood in between us. The male seemed
 to calm down and I went into the
 corridor to retrieve my glasses from the floor.

The male then left the unit with some others.

Following this incident I have sustained a 1 inch
 cut to my left eyebrow, which has been glued shut,
 and a 2 inch cut on my left scapula, which has
 also been glued and plastered.

I've got a badly bruised eyeball, and scratches
 and bruising around my left eye.

I've sustained grazes to the left side of my forehead,
 and cuts and bite marks to the rear of my head, as
 well as swelling.

I received medical attention at the hospital straight
 after the incident.

The incident lasted for about 5-10 minutes.

The closest I was to the male was only a couple
 of inches from his face. Visibility was very good.

I do not know the male and have never seen him before.
