Dear Sir.

Trial for offence of harassment

I write to inform you that your application to vacate your trial has been granted by the court and that a new hearing date has been fixed for **26 March 2010 at 9.45am.** I enclose herewith a new bail form for you confirming that date and can advise you that if you fail to attend without good reason on that date the court may proceed and hear the case in your absence.

I note that at the first court hearing on 30 December 2009 you were not represented by a solicitor. I now note that in your correspondence of 19 January 2010 you indicate that you intend to instruct a solicitor to represent you. I would, therefore, request that you notify my office of the name and address of the firm that are to represent you at the trial and you are asked to do this by no later than 12noon on Wednesday 10 February 2010. If I have not heard from you by that date the court may be asked to make an order prohibiting you from cross-examining the witness in person and appointing a solicitor to carry out the cross-examination on your behalf. If the court is asked to make such an order you will be notified of the date when the request is to go before the court so that you may attend the hearing and make representations on your own behalf.
